Occupational Therapy Assistant (OTA)



Under the guidance of a registered Occupational Therapist (OT), OTAs can provide therapy and program support. The OT will collaborate with the OTA to develop a 3-week session plan tailored to your child's needs and goals, which the OTA will then implement via weekly face-to-face sessions with your child. The OTA will regularly check-in with the OT, allowing for any changes or adjustments to be made as required.

STRUCTURE:

The OT will discuss a possible plan around the frequency of support based around yours or your child's needs. The service is typically delivered in 10-week blocks. Below is an example of what your schedule could look like.

Week I	Joint session with the OT and OTA to confirm program of support
Week 2	Therapy session with the OTA
Week 3	Therapy session with the OTA
Week 4	Therapy session with the OTA, plus collaboration time between OTA and the OT
Week 5	Therapy session with the OTA
Week 6	Therapy session with the OTA
Week 7	Therapy session with the OTA, plus collaboration time between OTA and the OT
Week 8	Therapy session with the OTA
Week 9	Therapy session with the OTA
Week IO	Therapy session with the OTA, plus collaboration and reporting time between OTA and the OT

COST:

30-minute session = \$89.75 45-minute session = \$122.00
